All relevant qualifications must be nationally-accredited qualifications.

Qualifications above Bachelor level in the above areas also fulfil requirements for Diploma of Youth Work.

\* Bachelor of Social Science qualifications will provide exemption/credit dependent upon relevance of units studied to minimum requirements for SU Qld Chaplains. Academic transcripts will be required.

\*\* Diploma of Ministry/Christian Leadership qualifications will provide exemption/credit dependent upon relevance of units studied to minimum requirements for SU Qld Chaplains. Academic transcripts will be required.

# Graduates of Theology and/or Ministry courses are encouraged to complete units of the SU Qld Diploma to supplement/complement their studies.

**PLEASE NOTE:** SU Qld cannot employ Chaplains who do not meet NSCSWP (National School Chaplaincy and Student Welfare Program) minimum qualification requirements. Chaplains are required to have a minimum qualification of Cert 4 IV in Youth Work OR Certificate IV in Pastoral Care OR equivalent or higher qualification. The qualification must include the identified mental health AND referrals units: CHCCS422A - *Respond holistically to client issues and refer appropriately*; and CHCMH301B - *Work effectively in mental health*.
